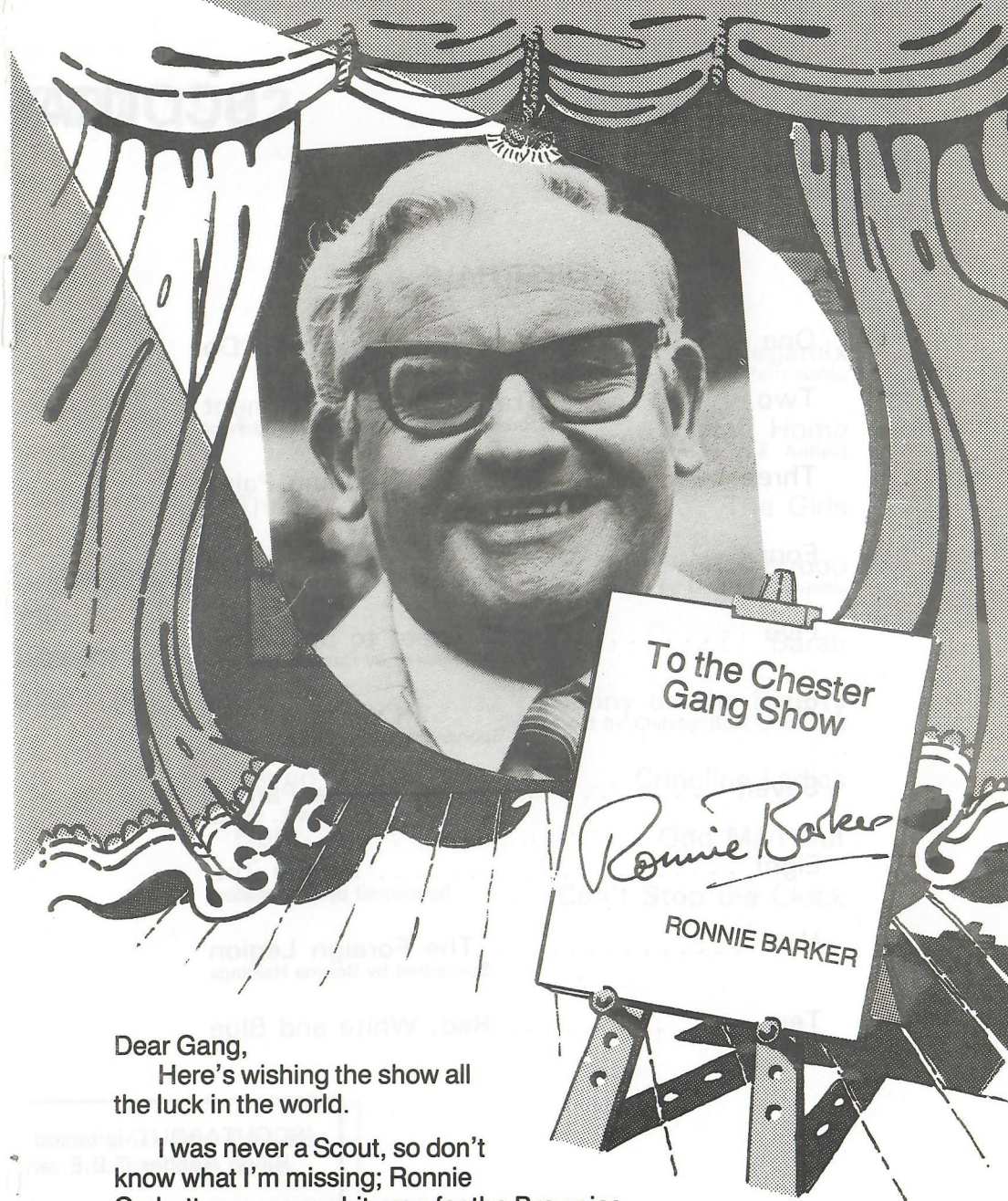
CIVIC NIGHT — THURSDAY 26th MARCH

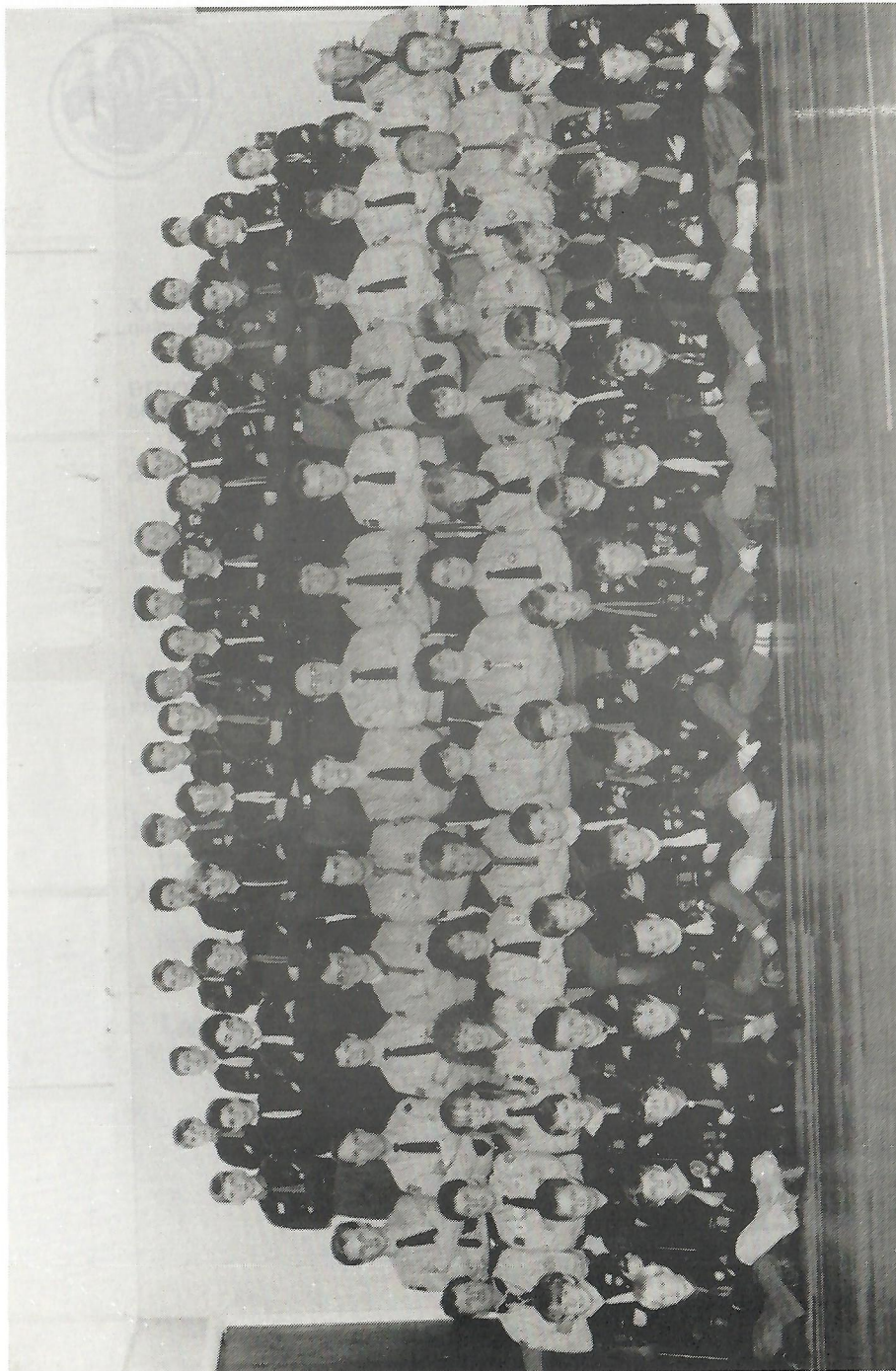
