

Roy Fisher 1928-2002



It is now just a year since Roy died during the week of our last show. He was one of a rapidly disappearing breed; his commitment to voluntary work (and Scouting in particular) was exceptional. He was associated with "Scoutabout", as the original Chester Gang Show was called, from 1953 when we staged our first production in the Refectory of Chester Cathedral. By 1958 we had moved to the old Royalty Theatre in City Road (now sadly, demolished) and that was the year in which Roy took over as Producer, his wife Madge being Prompter. He was responsible for 32 shows (as was Ralph Reader), initially from 1958 to 1979 and then secondly from 1987 to 1995.

In addition to his work with "Scoutabout", Roy was also Senior Scout Leader and then from 1954, Group Scout Leader of the 8th Chester Scout Group. He was a holder of the Medal of Merit and the Silver Acorn for services to Scouting. Roy was a cheerful and a gregarious character, a product of the pioneering days of the Movement. We have all lost a dedicated colleague and a very good friend.


