

Full of character and replete with cosy nooks, The Plough is also richly furnished with comfortable bars and open fires, whilst traditional hand pumps dispense an impressive range of select cask ales. The food surpasses standard pub fare by a country mile - and using locally sourced quality ingredients, all food is home-cooked, featuring classic dishes such as steak-burgers, Sunday roasts and Head Chef Matt Parry's 'Three Little Pigs' signature dish, which was so popular on the 'specials' board that it's now part of their main menu! Other great meals on offer include the epic slow-cooked lamb shank with rosemary, garlic and red wine jus, root mash and creamed cabbage.



VERDICT: The quintessential English pub, where time slows to a leisurely pace and the hours slip by in pastoral bliss. But don't be idle - get your walking boots on and head for The Plough!
