Many things have changed since that first pilot production for a future District Gang Show at the College School in 1938 such as the venues, the uniform and the integration of girls into the movement. CHESTER GANG SHOW 2020



You might be a parent of a performer in the Gang. You may be seeing a Gang Show for the first time. Or you may be a seasoned audience member looking forward to another fun-filled performance. But have you ever wondered what goes on behind the scenes to make Gang Show happen?



We caught up with Leaders Mark Turnbull, and Nick and Cat Hirst, as well as some of the Scouts themselves, to find out more about the first half finale item 'Teenage Dirtbag,' and what Gang Show means to them.



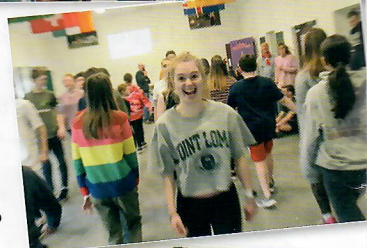
"We created Teenage Dirtbag as a modern twist on Cinderella," explained Nick, "with the traditional damsel in distress replaced by book-ish Eddy who likes writing songs. Noelle, the story's Prince Charming, is fed up with all the macho oafs in her school (read Ugly Sisters) who make her and Eddy's life hell."

"The highlight for me though is 'Saturday night's alright for fighting,'" said Cat. "We knew we had to do an Elton John number after watching Rocketman. It was such an amazing film. And we wanted a big bang, so it was just perfect."

Mark added, "The kids have really taken to it, and the volume of the singing is amazing. When you combine it with the choreography, it's just something really special to watch. When you choose songs that kids know and relate to..you just get so much more energy out of them. We're so proud of them all."

All three directors have been involved with Gang Show since they were teenagers themselves. 'As a kid, being in Gang Show was amazing fun, and gave me so much confidence,' said Mark. 'Performing in front of three hundred people at the old Gateway Theatre was such a buzz, and it's brilliant to be able to pay that back, and help the next generation of Scouts do the same.'

And the young performers have clearly enjoyed the experience. "It's really, really fun. Getting to know new people, and all the acting, singing and dancing has been brilliant," said Tomos. Nya and Kiera added, "It's like family. We're friends together. Teenage Dirtbag is really energetic..it's definitely got the fastest dances. The songs fit the story so well. I don't know what I'm going to do when Gang Show is over!" 'I think there's a little bit of magic watching a group of young people pull something together like a Scout Gang Show,' said Nick. "We're really inclusive. There are no auditions to join the Gang, and everyone gets a chance to perform if they want to be involved, and yet they achieve such a brilliant, heart-warming result. It's why so many of us get involved over the months leading up to the show to help make it happen, whether it's directing, making costumes, building scenery, running the tech and so on. We all want to give the young people the best possible experience. And it's fantastic to be able to show the public what Scouting is all about.'



lyrics that she loves," adds Cat, "she offers the mystery writer the chance to have the last dance with her at the Summer Ball. It's the fairy-tale equivalent of the glass slipper."

"There's been a lot in the media recently about bullying and self-esteem, and the gang have really embraced items which have focused on contemporary issues like that in the past," said Nick. "So we wanted to go with the message that it doesn't matter who you are, or who your friends are...as long as you're having a good time, and everyone is happy, then that's all that matters. It's a feel good thing!"

Like many of the show's items, Teenage Dirtbag features exciting dance routines set to modern pop tunes. "The title song was originally by Wheatus, but we've used a choral version by Scala & Kolacny Brothers, as it worked better for rehearsals," explained Mark, who took the lead on music for the item. "And the classic Hall & Oates number 'you make my dreams' is really exciting. It's a played track which we've done a bit of a montage to. Watch out for the stage moving around during that one!"

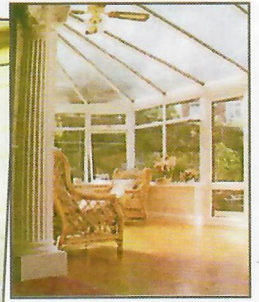
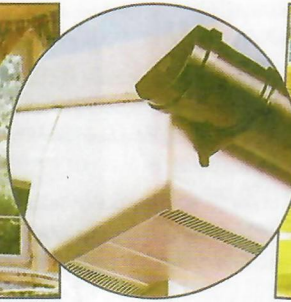
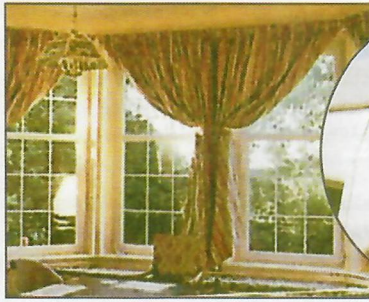

Cheshire Scouting has benefitted greatly from donations from local Freemason lodges.

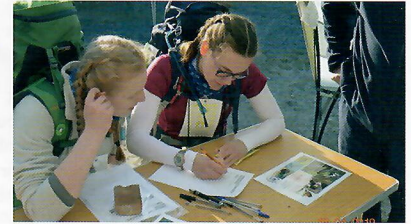

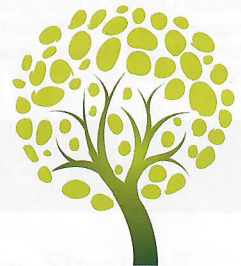

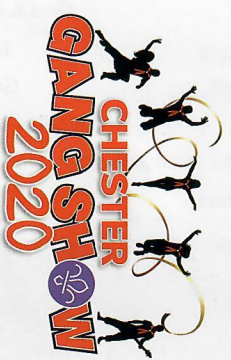
The camp also has a strong empowerment theme, with the aim of encouraging the attendees to be active citizens, and to make a positive difference within their local communities and the wider world on their return.
