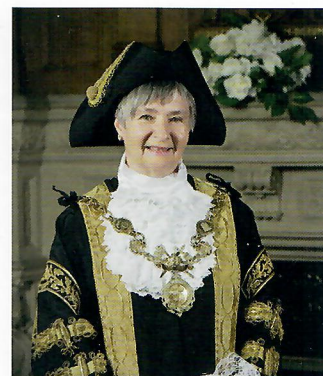

It gives me great pleasure to welcome you to our 67th Production of Chester Gang Show. It's so nice to see our regulars back again and to say a great big "hello!" to everyone watching for the first time, we hope it's not your last.

This year we have seen a change in our Youth Producer team and thank Alex Morris-Coker and Cameron Morrison for their contributions to our Production process over the last few years. We welcome Grace Robson-Traynor as our new Youth Producer who has embraced this role with enthusiasm and who now understands a lot more of the processes behind the show and can enlighten our Gang members to have a more inclusive Show, and to this end Grace has introduced the Gang Show Youth Forum with a number of successful meetings to date. We also welcome Keira Fennell as Assistant Youth Producer for the Senior gang and Romy Bonsall-Redston as Assistant Youth Producer for the Junior Gang, a new post introduced this year, both these assistant Youth Producer roles were balloted and voted for by the Cast, we wish them all well in their new roles.

We continue to focus on maintaining the history, heritage and continuity of this great Scouting activity locally for future generations of young people as it is so important in providing unique opportunities to develop new skills and grow self-confidence. Many previous gang members are now following their chosen dream or career paths thanks to their Gang Show experience. When asked "what's Gang Show?", it's quite difficult to explain really. I know what it is in my head having personally been involved since 1967 as a Cub! but how do you get this truly unique opportunity across to someone new to Gang Show? I suppose the easiest way to describe this great activity is by liking it to a variety show with singing, dancing, sketches, laughter, and sometimes tears, but it delivers so much more than just the "on-stage" experience. Gang Show is the result of many people pulling together and putting in a tremendous amount of time and hard work. As a team event involving Beavers, Cubs, Scouts, Explorers, Network, Leaders and volunteers, Gang Show has no equal; it brings out the best in people and encourages personal development and self-esteem in the true spirit of Scouting and what it has to offer and showcases this on stage. It is a shining example of what we need to encourage so that Scouting in Chester and District remains vibrant for many years ahead, continuing to provide young people with Skills for life! I can't thank everyone enough for being a part of this amazing Chester Gang Show Team.

Following our performances last year with AmaSing, a local charity, to be a part of their week-long series of shows at the Storyhouse Theatre in Chester at the end of June along with 500 primary school children and some other invited guest performers, we were this year asked to be a part of their "Inspire" series of performances and performed at two Shows at the William Aston Hall in Wrexham in June and then for two performances in July at the Deva Football Stadium in Chester, both with over 500 Primary school children and other supporting acts. Another fantastic opportunity to showcase Gang Show in two unique venues with our young people giving some other performers a run for their money! Wow, makes you feel so proud!

Our Gang Show Team were also asked to help provide the "entertainments" at Chester District Camp at Tatton Park Scout Camp Site in early July with many of the Gang again taking part whilst on camp performing to about 500 Campers from all sections of the District. I seem to remember the whole camp singing Happy Birthday to me for my 65th Birthday on camp, the things you do for Scouting.

Having started our process as normal this year we were able to plan and organise our much-loved Gang Show Camp in October for the Senior Gang and again this year we invited our Junior Gang along for an activity day, so they got to experience some of the fun and activities. The Junior Gang have also had their own sleepover with Gang Show themed activities. My sincere thanks to everyone who helped organise and deliver these two events which proved very popular as always.

It is with great sadness that I have to report that Lil Edmunds one of our previous Wardrobe mistresses from over 50 years ago and long standing and much-loved District Scouter sadly passed away at the end of last year at the great age of 103 years old! she will be missed and remembered by many of us. I would also like to mention two other supporters of Scouting and Gang Show who tragically passed away this year, Margaret Plenderleath and Jane Hickson and who's families have our thoughts and prayers.

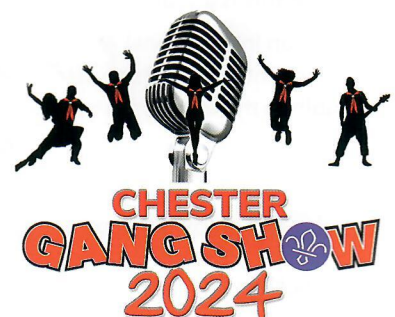

I would like to thank you all for coming to see our show and supporting the Chester Scouts.

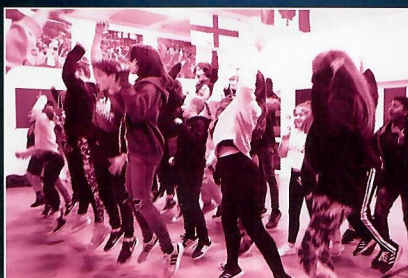
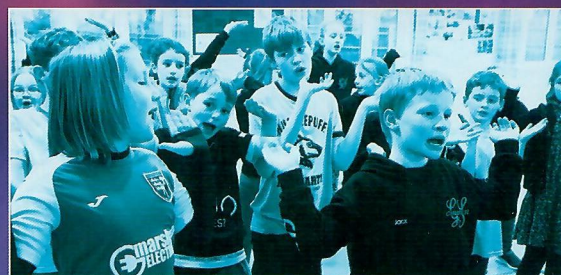
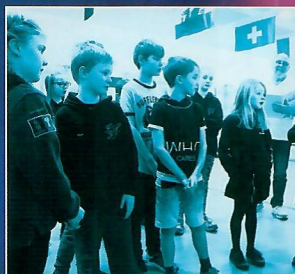
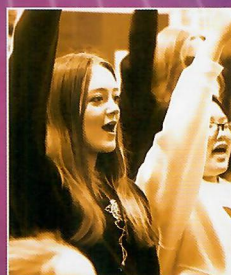
