PRODUCER LETTERS

It gives me great pleasure to welcome you to our 68th Production of Chester Gang Show. It's so nice to see our regulars back again and to say a great big "hello!" to everyone watching for the first time, we hope it's not your last.

This year has been a difficult one for everyone involved with Chester Gang Show. In November one of our Senior Gang members, Evan Rothwell (11), was involved in a fatal road traffic accident on his way home from school, indeed this very school, King's School Chester having only started in September. This was such a devastating loss to us all but resulted in much courage and friendship and togetherness as a Gang to overcome this tragedy and carry on with the show, although we had to quickly alter some content as a mark of respect, Evan would have wanted this. Evan started in Chester Gang Show in 2020 as a Beaver and then like us all due to Covid lockdown was part of our "Virtual" Show and activities in 2021 before we started back again in 2022 with Evan as a very enthusiastic Cub in "The Saga of the Norselands" as a Viking warrior, one of his defining roles! 2023 saw Evan return as a Cub and then as a Scout in the Senior Gang in 2024 where he had much fun taking money off our MD Colin Parfitt (if you saw it you'll know!). Evan had such an infectious personality and constant smile and lit up any space he was in always wanting to give his best and make people laugh and smile with his tricks and cheese jokes! Nobody could "dis-a-brie" with that (sorry, that's one for you Evan). Evan was also one of our Scouts at my Group, Cestrian, where I am GLV, so a double blow for me and the Group. After a period of reflection at both Group and Gang Show, the resolve was to carry on and everyone to be "a little more Evan". I think the Gang have stepped up and become "a little more Evan" and I'm so pleased that his sister Juliet has found the courage and stayed with us in the Junior Gang. I must pay tribute to Evan's parents who have shown incredible strength and resolve throughout, and our thoughts and prayers will remain with you and your family. The Gang were honoured to be asked to be a part of Evan's memorial service and perform our signature Finale songs, Great, Great, Game and Crest of a Wave to the congregation. This was an extremely moving moment, one the Gang coped admirably with, I'm sure I heard Evan sing 2,3,4 with a big smile on his face! Thank you, Evan for being such an inspiration to us all with your enthusiasm and dedication, I would gladly of passed the baton of Producer on to you one day, a role that I know you talked about.



It is also with great sadness that I have to report that Eric Plenderleath, a long time member of Chester Gang show, previous Producer, District Commissioner, Lord Mayor of Chester amongst others and latterly as our Treasurer until three years ago, sadly passed away in December virtually 12 months after his wife Margaret. He will be missed and remembered by many of us and our thoughts and prayers are with his family and friends.

We continue to focus on maintaining the history, heritage and continuity of this great Scouting activity locally for future generations of young people as it is so important in providing unique opportunities to develop new skills and grow self-confidence. Many previous Gang members are now following their chosen dream or career paths thanks to their Gang Show experience. When asked "what's Gang Show?", it's quite difficult to explain really. I know what it is in my head having personally been involved since 1967 as a Cub! But how do you get this truly unique opportunity across to someone new to Gang Show? I suppose the easiest way to describe this great activity is by linking it to a variety show with singing, dancing, sketches, laughter, and sometimes tears, but it delivers so much more than just the "on-stage" experience. Gang Show is the result of many people pulling together and putting in a tremendous amount of time and hard work. As a team event involving Beavers, Cubs, Scouts, Explorers, Network, Leaders and volunteers, Gang Show has no equal; it brings out the best in people and encourages personal development and self-esteem in the true spirit of Scouting and what it has to offer and showcases this on stage. It is a shining example of what we need to encourage so that Scouting in Chester and District remains vibrant for many years ahead, continuing to provide young people with Skills for life! I can't thank everyone enough for being a part of this amazing Chester Gang Show Team.

Following our previous performances at the Storyhouse Theatre in Chester, the William Aston Hall in Wrexham and the Deva Football Stadium in Chester with AmaSing, a local charity, we did not get chance this year to join them as they secured a surprise audition for "Britain's Got Talent" and got through to the Semi-finals! A fantastic achievement, I'm sure you probably watched it. Evan was also a part of that experience! The Senior Gang were asked to perform by the District to open the District AGM in May, another opportunity to come together and perform.

Having started our process as normal this year we were able to plan and organise our much-loved Gang Show Camp in October for the Senior Gang and again this year we invited our Junior Gang along for an activity day, so they got to experience some of the fun and activities. The Junior Gang have also had their own sleepover with Gang Show themed activities. My sincere thanks to everyone who helped organise and deliver these two events which proved very popular as always.

We have again said "farewell" to a number of key members of the Gang this year as they move onto university and start their careers, but equally we have welcomed many new faces from all sections, which is encouraging for the future, and they have all excelled and shown that this part of their Scouting means a great deal to them. As you watch all our young people perform on stage, I'm sure you will agree that they have embraced with enthusiasm and resilience everything that they have been asked to do and have more than maintained the standards we try so hard to meet and improve year on year. We are proud of each and every one of them. Well done!

Of course, none of this is possible without the help and encouragement of our brilliant Production Team who are tireless in their commitment and enthusiasm producing high quality specially written and choreographed items, whilst also updating some "old favourites", which is rubbing off on newer youth members of the team, and those who want to join the team. Without this level of help and dedication, Chester Gang Show would not be what it is today! Check out the QR tile with the acknowledgements for more details. I would therefore like to express my sincere thanks to the whole team supporting Gang Show 2025 and to the many other people, both within & outside Scouting, for their support and loyalty, and for giving the opportunity to the Gang to continue this annual Scouting activity.

I would also like to thank John Lambert our Assistant Producer for his unquestionable support and dedication in helping me maintain our standards and improve with each new show. Big thanks also to Grace Robson-Traynor our Youth Producer who has embraced this role with enthusiasm and who now understands a lot more of the processes behind the show and can enlighten our Gang members to have a more inclusive Show, and to this end Grace has introduced the Gang Show Youth Forum with a number of successful meetings to date. Grace is also a much-valued member of the Production Team. Thanks also to Keira Fennell as Assistant Youth Producer for the Senior Gang and Romy Bonsall-Redston as Assistant Youth Producer for the Junior Gang and whose primary roles are to liaise with the younger Gang and Production Team, and both have stepped up to help direct this year. I must also thank my wife Rachel and daughter Ellie for their constant support and encouragement, as always, I could not do it without you.

Finally, I must thank you, our audience, for your continued support. Without you we simply would not be able to do it and so give young people the opportunity and experience they may otherwise never get. So, sit back and let the members of Chester and District Scout Gang Show brighten your day with singing, dancing and laughter. So sit back and have a fun filled Gang Show experience as "We're Having A Party" "Where The River Meets The Sea", and who knows what "Ripples" may occur, but "Jumpin' Jack", there might be "A Fight For The Crown" as long as they don't get "Court In The Act", and "Lest We Forget", "Scouts Welcome Adventure"! 

Hello, welcome to Chester Gang Show 2025!







Fun Fact:

Chester Gang Show has taken place almost every year since 1953, and 2025 sees our 68th production. The first show was in the Cathedral Refectory and since then Gang Show has taken place at the Royalty Theatre, ABC Cinema, Gateway Theatre, King's School, Catholic High School and our current home at Vanbrugh Theatre at King's School.



Fun Fact:

Apart from our main show week, in recent years we have also had the opportunity to perform at Storyhouse, Chester Football Stadium, Wrexham William Aston Building, District Camp and Chamboree and previously at community events such as the Brook Street Carnival and the Crocky Trail firework display, representing and promoting not only Gang Show but Scouting in Chester.



Fun Fact:

We pride ourselves with the quality and content of our productions and strive to achieve near professional standards. This takes a lot of work and dedication from a lot of people, not least our brilliant cast. For our 2025 show, rehearsals have taken place over 20 weeks amounting to over 100 hours in total.



Fun Fact:

Our total cast in 2025 numbers an amazing 80 young people including Beavers, Cubs, Scouts, Explorers, and Network. A similar number of over 70 Adult helpers and volunteers working in production, costume, stage crew, front of house, catering, technical and business to give the Gang the opportunity to take part in this incredible District Activity.



Fun Fact:

Our 2024 Production was seen by a total audience of 1196 including Scout and Guide Groups from across the District and beyond, representatives of other Gang Shows from across the Country, family and friends, dignitaries, special guests and general public, and once again received brilliant reviews.
