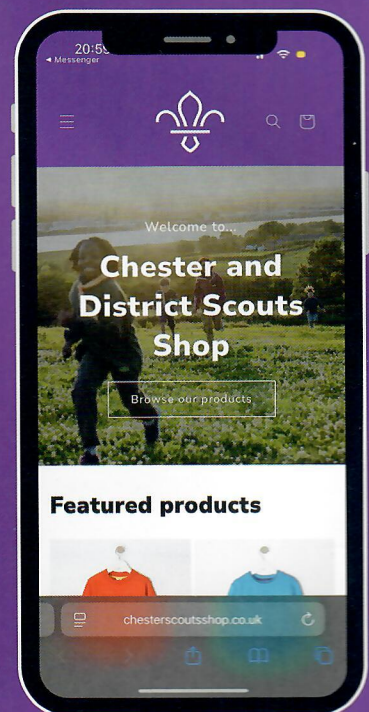

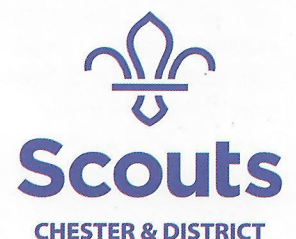

Yes, we are only one away from our 70th Platinum Jubilee show in 2027 with some plans already in place. This will be a special and memorable show as I will be then stepping down as Producer as will John Lambert our Assistant Producer and Colin Parfitt our Musical Director as we feel the time will be right to pass the baton on to the next generation with our succession planning so that we continue to focus on maintaining the history, heritage and continuity of this great Scouting activity locally for future generations of young people as it is so important in providing unique opportunities to develop new skills and grow self-confidence. Many previous Gang members are now following their chosen dream or career paths thanks to their Gang Show experience. When asked "what's Gang Show?", it's quite difficult to explain really.
